This year's tours will take place in the fall. Discussion on how long each visit should be. (40 minutes was agreed upon as a reasonable amount of time). Some businesses face potential challenges with weather and safety protocol. Spoke of organizing Teacher Wage Tours again. Due to in-service scheduling, plans must be made a year in advance.
